Standing Rules

New Members

Prospective new members must have a current Business License, Certified Pool Operator (CPO) License, or Tech I.

Prospective new members must attend three consecutive meetings prior to joining El Dorado IPSSA chapter.

Prospective new members must pass the IPSSA Water Chemistry test before becoming a member.

New members must pay a \$150.00 application fee (payable to El Dorado IPSSA) and two months dues @ \$84.77 per month plus \$15.00 packet fee totaling \$184.54 (payable to IPSSA Management Inc).

Meeting Attendance

Regular members must attend 8 meetings a year or 2 meetings per quarter. A fine will be imposed for each member not attending required number of meetings per quarter. The fine will be \$25.00 for the first quarter, \$50.00 for second quarter, and \$100.00 for third quarter. Member will be suspended if fine is not paid before the end of following quarter. El Dorado IPSSA does not hold meetings in July or December. Employee members are not required to attend meetings.

Employee Members

For the purposes of IPSSA an "employee" will be considered anyone who services, cleans, repairs, or maintains a pool of which an IPSSA member is in direct control. The "employee" may be considered a sub contractor, lessee, helper, casual laborer, non compensated individual, or employee. The only exception to this rule will be the full member's spouse or minor children. The term employee in this document is to have no effect on any Internal Revenue Service inquiries. **Any full member not disclosing his/her employees will be subject to suspension or expulsion from the Chapter.** The charge for employee members will be \$165.00, two months @ \$82.50, (payable to IPSSA Management Inc). It is recommended that employees obtain water chemistry certification.
